Youth 4-H & FFA Livestock Project Agreement

This program is to assist 4-H and FFA students in financing their expenses for their market animals **ONLY**. A New Project Agreement is required annually. **This credit account is for feed, feeding equipment, animal health and show supplies. Failure to comply with this policy may cause termination of this agreement.**

This account will be carried by Rockingham Cooperative, with no interest, for the duration of the project but not to exceed twelve (12) months. The account is due and payable within thirty (30) days after the project completion date (when the student receives payment for the sale of their animal(s) or the twelve (12) month period, whichever comes first. If the account is not paid within this time period, a monthly finance charge of 1.5% (\$1.50 minimum) will be applied to any unpaid balances (determined as provided in the Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc. Credit Plans delivered herewith and made a part hereof), in accordance with billings and the current payment schedule; Holder agrees to pay a 35% attorney's fee and other costs of collection in the event of default. Holder further agrees to notify Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc. promptly in writing of loss, theft, or unauthorized use of the account; that the account may be cancelled by Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc. at any time; to surrender the account upon demand; that any claim of Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc. against Holder shall, at Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc.'s option, become immediately due and payable upon failure of Holder to perform any terms hereof or make any payments as otherwise agreed; that Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc. may upon 15 days' prior written notice to the company, amend or change any provision or term of this Agreement or the Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc. Credit Plans; that the law of Virginia shall govern all rights and duties hereunder; that venue and jurisdiction for the enforcement of the obligations hereunder shall be in Rockingham County, Virginia, unless another venue and jurisdiction is agreed to, in writing, by Rockingham Cooperative Farm Bureau, Inc.
